



Currently there are many break and enters, and theft from vehicles in the Belvedere area. Again, I cannot stress enough to report crime; use the online reporting tool for thefts \$4999.00 and under. Of course, this reporting is tedious and feels like a pain in the back, however EPS analyst review higher crime areas and relate this information to the patrolling officers. Use mobile access #377 or call non-emergency line 780-423-4567.

Use 911 only if emergency, crime in progress, fire or in need of an ambulance.

Please watch out for persons loitering as catalytic converter thefts are on the increase If you catch somebody on your cameras and that information / photos can be of assistance to the police, I ask that you share that information with them.

Taxpayers should be vigilant when they receive, either by telephone, mail, text message or email, a fraudulent communication that claims to be from the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) requesting personal information such as a social insurance number, credit card number, bank account number, ...

Emails · Letter · Sample Telephone Scam · Sweepstakes Scheme · E-Mail Phishing

Fraud Prevention Tip: You can check your credit for free at least once every year on Equifax and TransUnion. You can also use Credit Karma's credit monitoring for free anytime!

These businesses allow you to review your report for signs of suspicious activity, such as accounts that you don't recognize, or inquiries from companies you've never done business with. These could be signs that someone is applying for credit in your name.


