


Thank you as well to all the community residents that take an active role in picking up garbage when they are out for walks around the neighbourhood.

BEWARE!.... Thieves look for every opportunity to break and enter or attempt to steal goods that can be sold on Kijiji and elsewhere.

Important tips: take pictures/record anything of value... more importantly to write down the make, model and serial number of possessions.

What to Check:

- GARAGE is it closed? Is it locked?
- VEHICLE(s) are the windows closed? Are there any valuables within sight? Are all of the doors locked?
- **HOME** are all of the accessible windows closed? Are all of the doors locked? Are there any valuables within sight from the exterior?

We each must do our part by paying attention to those that may be lurking in our alleyways, please NOTE time of day with description of person(s).

I understand it takes a bit on the phone to report but please do so, every piece of information helps.

This is a routine that should be done any time you park your vehicle, before you leave your house, and before you go to bed.



NEW EPS APP

Access everything for the EPS in just one single app on your mobile device. Download for your iOS or Android device.

Features:

- **News**: Read what's happening in Edmonton through our media release RSS feed.
- **Alerts:** Be notified when EPS has activated an alert (ex. Missing Person).
- **Report a Crime**: Report one of 6 types of crime through your mobile device!
- **Collision Reporting Tips**: If you've been in a collision, don't stress! We've got the steps you should take to get you through it.
- Locate a Police Station: Using your phone's GPS, locate the nearest EPS station.
- **Social Media**: EPS' corporate accounts for Facebook, Twitter, YouTube, Pinterest, and Instagram.
- **Recruiting**: What does it takes to be a member? Access the Join EPS website and social media accounts
- **Success Stories**: Get to know the EPS and our members' participation throughout the City.
- **Crime Files**: Assist the EPS; view Edmonton's Missing Persons, Caught on Camera, Assist to Identify, and Most Wanted files.
