PUMPKIN MUFFINS- Gluten Free

Ingredients:

1 cup applesauce unsweetened

1/2 tsp apple cider vinegar

1/4 tsp nutmeg

1/4 tsp salt

1 tsp vanilla

2 tbsp melted butter cooled

1 cup oats

1 cup chocolate chips 70% cacao

3/4 tsp baking soda

1 tsp cinnamon

1/4 tsp allspice

15 oz canned pumpkin

2 tbsp maple syrup optional

3 large eggs

1 cup oat flour

Instructions:

Preheat oven to 375°F

In a large bowl, dissolve baking soda, vinegar, cinnamon, nutmeg, allspice, and salt in applesauce Add canned pumpkin and mix well

Add vanilla, butter, syrup, and eggs and mix until uniform

Stir in oats, oat flour, and chocolate chips

Spray non-stick spray into silicone molds or muffin tins and spoon batter to fill each cup 3/4 of the way Bake at 375°F for 15 minutes for mini muffins or 25 minutes for full-sized muffins

PONDERING THOUGHTS


- The days are getting darker therefore we need to ensure that our property has good lighting. Sensor lights are a good asset to have. Helps with seeing if anyone is lurking in the yard shrubs.

- Just being present outside walking around the block and your alley can help deter crime, means we care to pay attention.

Let's Get Ready for Fall

One fantastic tip is to ensure if out and about that you wear something reflective and/or light coloured.

- Get your furnace inspected (for wood burning fireplaces, etc. clean chimney)
- Check for drafts and seal exterior doors and windows check for foundation cracks
- Clean those gutters
- Trim those trees, bushes
- Winterize plumbing, A/C if need be
- Make an appointment to change to snow tires and winter inspection
- Change the batteries for smoke detectors and check carbon monoxide detector
- Check over the snowblowers so ready to use
- Hang those Christmas lights
- Pack away summer clothes
- Get out those mittens, scarves, tuques, boots
- Bring out that snow shovel and extension cord
- Get sand, and ice melt
- Just maybe start Christmas shopping
