RINK ATTENDANT



Belvedere Community is hiring a Rink Attendant for our Upcoming Winter Season.

Responsibilities of this position will include but are not limited to the following:

1. Flooding and maintaining two outside ice surfaces
2. Snow removal on both rinks and walkways as required
3. Open, monitor and close outdoor rinks.
4. Perform cleanup for rink areas and janitorial for rink shack area
5. Minor preventative maintenance on snow equipment
6. Ensure all rules and regulations pertaining to the facilities are adhered to by those in attendance.
7. Maintain positive public relations, assistance and information services to user groups and the public.
8. Verification of membership / collection of skater fees
9. Selling of Community League memberships

This is a physically demanding position; incumbents will be required to work indoors and outdoors in a variety of adverse weather conditions. The number of hours of work per week may vary based on operational needs and/or weather conditions.

Qualifications:

- Experience operating equipment such as snow blowers, sweepers or other snow related equipment of similar size and complexity. An equivalent combination of training and experience will be considered
- Ice flooding and resurfacing a definite asset but if candidate does not have and is otherwise suitable, training will be provided
- Ability to perform manual labour for extended periods of time under all winter weather conditions.
- Ability to work independently
- Current valid Standard First Aid certification
- Successful candidate will be paid a monthly wage

Update on 64 St Park Project

The Right At Home Housing Society and NiGiNan Housing Ventures are working with the City of Edmonton and the residents of Belvedere Community to create a new public park at 12923 64 St. The goal of this project is to beautify the lot and create a place where local residents feel welcome to spend time and where they can connect with their neighbors.

This spring Right at Home hosted a community survey and spoke with residents of the building that it manages next to the park site. A report on what was heard through these activities will be available soon on the Belvedere Community League website.

Here is a sneak peek:

Overall, the neighbourhood residents that Right At Home Housing Society heard from about the new park would like to see and use features that allow them to sit and relax, gather and spend time with other people, and that provide spaces for gardening and for kids to play. People are most likely to use the park in the afternoon and evening, and are likely to visit the park alone and with many different relations, including friends, family, children, seniors and Elders. Community members that responded to the survey are largely supportive of a new park at this location, in particular those that live very close to it. Some people also shared their concerns, and these include safety, drug use, encampments, and proper maintenance.

The Right At Home Housing Societies next step on this park project is to work with the City of Edmonton to understand what resources and funding will be available to improve the site. Based on this information and on the feedback and ideas that residents shared in the spring, the next step after that will be developing a concept plan for the park. This plan will be shared with the community and then refined. Watch for updates in this newsletter and on the Belvedere Community League website.
