We desperately need bingo volunteers for our March bingo.

We currently are not receiving the income generated from monthly bingos, because we have no volunteers. This greatly impacts our ability to have community events. We are at risk of losing our bingo space unless we can start providing volunteers for the monthly assigned bingo dates.

If everyone committed to volunteer for just one bingo a year, we would be in great shape.

Each bingo is from 5pm to 12 pm and requires 12 to 15 workers. Free supper is provided. If you have a child in a recognized sports program and are a current community league member, you could earn \$75 for each bingo you work towards the sports registration.

Community Safety and Neighbourhood Watch

The request has gone into the City of Edmonton, for 31 Neighbourhood Watch signs to be hung on light poles around Belvedere. This should happen within the next month or so (also weather dependent). Also available are stickers for your front door to inform people that this is a Neighbourhood Watch Neighbourhood and that your home <u>will</u> report any suspicious or criminal activities. Should you wish for one of these stickers please email <u>communitypatrol@belvederecl.com</u> and I'll be happy to bring one to you.

We are always looking for residents to join the Belvedere Neighbourhood Watch Team to help with walks etc (on your schedule). So if you would like to join the team please email communitypatrol@belvederecl.com

You will also notice on the Belvedere Community Website that there is now a tab for Community Safety. Which will give you information and tips about all kinds of safety and a viewable/downloadable reference for all the needed phone numbers to "Make the Call". Coming shortly is also a page for Links and Resources. On facebook we now have an additional FB page, Belvedere Community Watch – for residents to post anything that might be happening around you to let others know, and information tips that you might be aware of.

We have been trying to add to everyone's toolbox tools to help you keep yourself and family safe and the knowledge to make that happen, but also information to help you understand what you might be seeing happening and what to do. The Belvedere Community League - Community Safety and Neighbourhood Watch has hosted two events – Personal Safety and Information about Street Drugs and Naloxone Training. If you missed these two events, they will be put on again in the future. These events have been chalk full of information for everyone and were well received by those who attended.

Also in the coming months, there are going to be sessions on; Self-Defense, First Aid CSA Intermediate Level C CPR & AED, Babysitting Course, Home Alone Course, and a Crime vs Houselessness presentation. Most are free to residents but others may have a very small fee required to ensure we have the attendance to warrant the courses. Stay tuned for the newsletter/flyers and announcements on facebook, nextdoor and the Belvedere website

But remember due diligence is needed by you as well, to keep the neighbourhood safe. Keep your sidewalks clear of snow – and if you can help out a neighbour who may need assistance with that. Turn on your front porch light! Let everyone see their way, but also let people know that you can see them as well. Same goes for your backyard. Do your 9 pm check routine to make sure everything is put away and everything is locked!
